## Sandgate House School

Sarah Carter set up a private girls school at Myrtle House (next door to the Rose Inn) High Street Sandgate and advertised in the 1881 and 1882 directories but by 1888-89 (directory) the family and business had moved to Sandgate House. The 1891 census for Sandgate House shows Sarah Carter aged 40 and her sister Elizabeth aged 36 as teacher along with Anna Elliott a teacher of German. There are two pupils living there also. Most of the pupils would probably have been day pupils.

Sandgate House is unoccupied in the 1894-5 directory and Mrs Dunne is living there by 1896-97 (pikes directory). It looks unlikely that Mrs Dunne had a school at this address but used it as a private residence.

The Carter's left Sandgate but it is unclear where they went.
